If you have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, you may qualify for utility assistance.

Requirements

- ✓ Be an Osceola resident
- ✓ Have a valid Driver's License or state ID
- ✓ Have a Social Security Card
- ✓ Have proof of COVID hardship (loss of income, laid off, reduced hours, furloughed)
- ✓ Have past due/delinquent electric, gas, or water utility bill
